Our Mission Statement

New Life City Church is committed to the Great Commission, given to us by our Lord Jesus Christ, which is to make disciples of all nations. This ministry of reconciliation will eventually result in the planting of churches of similar vision and philosophy that will perpetuate and fulfill God's commission.

Our Vision

NLCC is a Mission-Involved Church

The purpose and objectives of the church's mission program are well-known by the church members. Every member is passionately involved in missions. Every member prays faithfully for a city or a least-evangelized people group. He/She releases funds into the mission fields, goes on regular mission trips and is actively engaged in evangelism or community work in the mission field.

NLCC is a Missions-Sending Church

Through its mission programs, many faithful members are called into full-time or bi-vocational ministry. These candidates are adequately trained and strategically sent as career missionaries into the mission fields, planting and nurturing many cell-based churches and community works.

NLCC is a Missions-Partnering Church

Through its mission programs, the leadership of the church network with other national churches and agencies, their pastors and leaders, to further the cause of evangelism and the equipping of the ministers.

Our Objectives

- I. To mobilize the NLCC cells to adopt cities or least-evangelized people groups; and to target these communities in their prayers, mission pledges as well as mission trips.
- II. To create and increase mission awareness in the church through conventions, seminars, mission trips, mission updates and other forms of publicity and literature.
- III. To develop and execute an effective church planting strategy both locally and overseas.
- IV. To recruit, train, develop, send and supervise NLCC missionaries in mission work and church planting.
- V. To network with national churches and other agencies in evangelism as well as to equip pastors and leaders in the cell-church philosophy and strategy development.

Missions Support or Sponsorship

Missions Impact (MI) Teams

- I. Persons needing sponsorship can apply for financial assistance to finance the mission trip/work
- II. Full-time undergraduate students or youth; 30% subsidy for airfare, accommodation and transport of the MI trip budget.
- III. The church will cover ministry related expenses such as love offerings to interpreters, pastors, churches and institutions.
- IV. The church will sponsor full-time pastors who accompany or lead the MI team.
- V. MI budget for accommodation is a backpacker accommodation rate.
- VI. Budget of any missions trip has to be presented to the board for approval.

Exploratory Trips

- I. For missions representatives going, the church will reimburse certain transport, accommodation and food costs – each team will submit a budget to the missions committee for approval prior to travel. A report is expected at the end of each trip.
- II. If the church requests for the pastor to represent the church, the church will fully sponsor this trip. The missions committee will approve the related travel budget.
- III. All exploratory and MI trips will need the prior approval of the missions committee and church elders.

- III. To equip and send out “one family unit” NLCC missionaries by 2011 and another family unit by 2014.
- IV. To Plant two churches in Asia by 2011.
